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SMARTSCORE RANKINGS

TOP RANKED STOCKS BASED ON OUR SMARTSCORE RANKING

The SmartScore stock market ranking system was created by veteran trader, economist, and investor Jerry Robinson to follow the “smart money” by identifying stocks matching the following specific fundamental criteria:

- 1) New Institutional buying**
- 2) Existing Institutional buying**
- 3) High profitability (Net Income)**
- 4) High/Stable Earnings per Share (EPS)**
- 5) Low Total Liabilities**
- 6) Strong Corporate Insider buying**
- 7) High Quarterly EPS Estimates**

In addition to our strict fundamental criteria, we also weed out stocks based on technical analysis (*only on U.S. stocks.*)

Currently, we only apply the following technical criteria to our list of U.S. stocks only.

- ▶ **The current price must be trading above the stock's 200 DMA (200-Day Moving Average)**
- ▶ **The stock's price must be \$5 or greater**
- ▶ **Most recent quarterly YOY earnings must be positive**
- ▶ **Institutional investors must own at least 40% of the stock, but no more than 75%**
- ▶ **The stock's average daily trading volume must be at least 250,000**

Each weekend, we update our Smartscore rankings on 22 different categories of stocks (China, Solar Energy, Blockchain, and many more.)



SMARTSCORE METHODOLOGY

HOW WE IDENTIFY OUR WEEKLY LIST OF THE TOP-RANKED STOCKS

OUR PROPRIETARY "SMARTSCORE" SYSTEM RANKS STOCKS BASED ON SEVEN KEY CRITERIA:

1

NEW INSTITUTIONAL BUYING

We consider it bullish if financial institutions begin making new purchases of a stock.

2

EXISTING INSTITUTIONAL BUYING

We consider it bullish if financial institutions are adding to their existing positions in a stock.

3

HIGH PROFITABILITY (NET INCOME)

The higher the net income, the higher we rank the stock.

4

HIGH/STABLE EPS

Companies with high and stable earnings per share over the last 12 months achieve a higher rank.

5

LOW TOTAL LIABILITIES

We penalize companies within our ranking system that carry excessive debt loads and prefer low debt levels.

6

STRONG INSIDER BUYING

We consider it bullish if corporate executives (insiders) are actively purchasing the stock.

7

HIGH QUARTERLY EPS ESTIMATES

Those companies which have higher EPS estimates for the upcoming quarter get a boost in our ranking system.
